Why do we teach Spanish as our Modern Foreign Language?

Spanish is a European language and is spoken in 20 countries across the world and is the world's second-most spoken native language. Spanish is taught in almost all of our pupil's secondary schools therefore we believe it is important to lay the foundations for this subject.

Modern Foreign Languages Implementation at Castleway

To achieve these aims, we have carefully planned out exactly what children learn in each year group, from Year 3-6. Our aim is to meet every individual pupils' need regardless of their background and where necessary identify gaps in knowledge. Our Modern Foreign Languages curriculum has carefully been sequenced to ensure learning is progressive and is reviewed regularly.

Modern Foreign Languages lessons and units of work at Castleway are carefully sequenced and progressive. Spanish lessons at Castleway will:

- Teach Spanish through songs, games, activities and role play using real life things and props,
- Incorporate elements of speaking, listening, reading and writing Spanish,
- Allow time for pupils to engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others;
- Offer pupils the opportunity to appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in Spanish,
- Give time for pupils to understand basic grammar in Spanish,
- Develop accurate pronunciation and intonation in pupils Spanish speaking,
- Provide pupils time to practice Spanish in order for the language to become more automatic,
- Review previous learning regularly,
- Offer pupils positive praise so that they feel successful in their learning,
- Provide pupils with feedback so that they are clear about how to make progress,
- Are taught by a qualified Spanish teaching expert with sound subject knowledge.

Modern Foreign Languages Impact at Castleway:

To check your child has learned what we have intended them to, we complete termly assessments. The purpose of this is for your child to apply the skills they have learnt and to see how much your child has understood through a unit of work. Teachers' then adapt their lessons to meet your child's needs.

To get a picture of what your child is retaining over time, teachers also use a range of formative assessment tools and observe the work children are completing in their lessons. Adults provide pupils regularly with feedback in order to address misconceptions and move pupils' learning on.
