Dear Families,

I hope you have had a lovely half term break and are looking forward to the start of another Castleway half term! Please excuse me writing to you on a Saturday but there are some important updates to share with you. As seems to be the norm for us now, it has been a really busy and incredibly productive half term break with lots for our children to see tomorrow!

So, whilst some of my updates detailed below will be a slight inconvenience for a short time, just think of how delicious the omelette will be when we've finished cooking! We are going to have fully refurbished facilities, brand new technology, bright and airy classrooms and an increased sense of pride in our school building. Pedestrian Access

Pedestrian access is open as normal from either Castleway North or via the Baffin Close gate. Until further notice, there is no access across the car park to the KS2 playground. So, if you're coming from Castleway North and need to get to the KS2 yard, please use the new path that runs down the nursery side of school and enter that way. Staff will be outside to direct and point you in the right direction so please don't worry.

Reception Class – Temporary Move

You'll have noticed that our mobile classroom has had a much-needed facelift making it fit for our children to use more regularly than they were. Whilst the works inside school continue, most classes will spend a short time in the 'CastleCabin' before it becomes our new community space. For at least the next 2 weeks, our Reception Class children will be based in the mobile classroom. Mrs. McCarthy spent the whole of yesterday making sure it's full of all the things that are familiar to our children so that their learning continues as normal... just in the 'CastleCabin' for now! If your child is in Reception Class, drop off and pick up will be from mobile classroom until further notice.

Car Park Update

You'll see that our car park improvements have been in full swing with our brand-new school gates taking pride of place. The old substation at the side of the kitchen has been demolished which will give us additional parking capacity. Whilst the team have worked at an amazing pace, the car park will not be completed by Monday.

If you must park at school, please use the ancillary car park on the field and follow the foot path to either the main entrance or use the path around the nursery side of school to gain access. Please do not cut across the car park or attempt to access school via the side of the hall. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you about the importance of considerate parking, particularly with regards to our neighbours.

Breakfast Club

Nursery School Breakfast Club will be operating as normal from 8am on Monday morning. Please continue to access school in the same way that you have been doing just remember that you can't access the carpark at the front of school at the moment. Primary School Breakfast Club is also operating as normal from 8am on Monday morning but all children will need to access via the main office until further notice. Please remember that there is no parking at the front of the school building until further notice.
