Building Work Update

Building work on our wonderful school is progressing at a rapid pace. When we returned to school on Monday, we were greeted by a **brand-new corridor leading to the new children's individual toilets**; these will be available to use following the Christmas break. You'll also have noticed a new door on the KS2 side of the building. This is a **temporary fire exit** until the brand-new doors and windows are installed. The temporary exit has been fitted to allow the work on our sensory room extension to start! This work should start in the new year.



Year One's classroom renovations will be completed in time for our return in January. The children have settled in to their temporary room and will remain there for the two days we are in school next week.



We're pleased to share with you that the **safety fencing on the car park** will be fitted next week. Whilst this will mean that parts of the car park are out of action, it does mean that our car park will have the added security and safety measures that will keep us all safe sooner rather than later.

We'll keep you posted with further updates and developments as our schools continue to grow and change to meet the needs of our children and families. We're incredibly proud of all that is happening at Castleway.

We're continuing the tradition started last year and we're off to the panto! All children in the Primary School (F2 to Y6) will be going to the Floral Pavilion on the morning of Friday, 6th January. 
