This includes being thoughtful to our neighbours in terms of their access to drive ways but also where you park on our site. Mr. Melvin and I will be introducing some new restrictions and access timings in September. We will, of course, ensure that you have plenty of notice about these changes. Any changes that we make will have the ultimate safety of our children and families in mind. Whilst some changes may be inconvenient, safety should always come first.

We have specific restrictions placed on us with regards to parking and the number of spaces that we have at school. These restrictions are not controlled by school, they are placed on us by the Local Authority and, believe it or not, Sport England also have an opinion on how we use our land too. We are doing the very best with the space that we have.
