
School Logo Feedback

Many thanks to those of you who were able to take part in our survey asking about the use of one consistent logo across both of our schools. The results were overwhelmingly in favour of this, only one of the respondents answered no.

No immediate change is needed and for Primary School families, in fact there is no change at all. Nursery School families are encouraged to get as much use as possible out of the current uniform you have bought. When it comes to buying new uniform for Nursery, you'll have the following choices:

- Plain navy-blue jumper or cardigan.
- Navy-blue jumper or cardigan with CURRENT Nursery School logo.
- Navy-blue jumper or cardigan with the same logo as the Primary School meaning that if your child moves up to F2 with us, there will be no need to buy new uniform. Unless you want to of course!

Hopefully you'll see this as another move to supporting our families and making life at our 'two Castleways' that little bit simpler and streamlined. During the Easter break, I got in touch with Design Stitch (on Tarran Way) to make them aware of the changes. They're ready to go with the amended Primary School logo for all who want to purchase it. Mini London Marathon

You may remember that Mrs. Kay took part in the London Marathon last year. Because of this, we've been invited to take part in the 'Mini London Marathon for Schools'. You'll know that we're proud to be an inclusive, representative and diverse school family. You may also be aware that June is LGBTQ+ Pride Month in the UK. As you'd expect, our curriculum covers all statutory requirements to spread the message of tolerance, acceptance and understanding. We do this because it's the right thing to do, not just because it's statutory.

To mark the end of 'Pride Month', Tuesday, 24th June will be our 4th annual 'Come as You Are' Day at Castleway where children are encouraged to come in to school wearing whatever they think represents them best. Transition Day - Staffing Organisation 2025/26



I know that the school organisation and classes for next year is already a hot topic for many of you at the moment. This is something that the Leadership Team and I are discussing and do reflect on regularly. Please be assured that the decision of which teacher is in which class is based on the experience and skills of our teaching staff and the needs of each cohort of children.

It is still incredibly early for information about next year to be shared, not least due to the fact that the teacher resignation date is 31st May for teachers to leave at the end of this academic year. Whilst I don't want any of our teachers to leave, there are progression opportunities available at other schools that teachers may wish to apply for. Also, there are budgetary considerations that cannot be discussed until Mrs. Kay and I meet with the Local Authority bursar team. Whilst the 'new financial year' started in April, Wirral are yet to hold their budget meetings with schools. Whilst this is in the diary and we have a good handle on the finances, there are some decisions which cannot be confirmed until after then. When the final decision is made and information is shared with families, we will also hold our 'reverse parents' evening' meetings to give families the chance to meet and chat with your child's next teacher. Rest assured, putting the children first is what we do at Castleway and preparing for them to move to their next class is no exception!

The transition day where children will 'move up for the day' and spend time with their next teacher is Wednesday 2nd July. Don't worry, this will not affect Year 2's Curriculum Celebration Afternoon.

Thank you, as always, for your continued help and support. Like I say, your involvement really is something that makes our school special.


